Necessary:

- Recent teacher graduate, OCT certified or working towards graduating
- Have experience working with children in an outdoor setting
- Have good organizational & communication skills
- Punctual and professional
- Passionate about: working outside, farming & growing food, sustainable agriculture, deepening children's connection to the earth
- Confidence to teach our programs to children from Kindergarten to Grade 8
- Recent vulnerable sector screening required (paid for by us if you do not already have one)

- Graduated from a related field (Education, Outdoor Education, Environmental Studies, etc.)
- Have farming experience growing vegetables, working with livestock, honey bees and/or vermicompost
- Have outdoor education experience
- Live in or have a strong knowledge of the Jane Finch community

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Commit to the full 4- or 8-week internship program (part- & full-time positions available)
- Lead engaging activities with groups of up to 15 students (K Grade 8)
- Assist with set-up & clean-up of activities
- Be prepared to work outside in all weather conditions (cold, rain, sun, heat)
- Able to lift up to 40lbs of soil, garden tools, etc.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Commit to the full 4-weeks of Summer Farm Camp, daily Monday to Friday, approx. 8:30-4:30pm
- Support staff in running activities including- nature crafts, gardening, cooking, survivalist activities
- Support staff in supervising campers (age 4-12), ensuring campers feel safe and respected
- Responsible for morning set-up, lunch time clean-up & end of day clean-up of activities
- Be prepared to work outside in ALL weather conditions including rain, sun & heat (this is an
 outdoor camp, with a very limited indoor space, we only go inside when there is an Environment
 Canada Weather Warning)
- Care for the children's garden: includes daily watering, weeding & harvesting

Positions & Dates:

- Volunteers will be required to attend all 4 full days of training July 3rd July 6th, 10am-3pm
- Positions are full time only (Monday Friday for all 4 weeks)
- Week 1: July 9-13
- Week 2: July 16-20
- Week 3 & 4: July 30 Aug 10
